'Nova'*.

Fairview Evergreen remains 100% family-owned and operated, with no outside interests or control. We manage 3,250 acres, including approximately 1,200 acres of nursery stock and 1,200 acres of small grains.

What's New for 2026

To improve efficiency and deliver additional savings, we're introducing a volume discount program, joining many of our peers in the industry. We will also continue to offer a 5% COD discount for payments made by cash or check and will add a \$5.00 per plant surcharge for orders under 10 plants.

Despite rising costs, we've kept our average price increase to just 2% for 2026—because fair pricing matters to us.

Practicing sustainable growing, including crop rotation with corn, oats, wheat, and Sudan grass to restore soil health.



JUNIPERUS CHINENSIS 'HETZ'S COLUMNARIS'



Our founder, Frank C. Hetz, made the original selection of *Juniperus chinensis 'Hetz's Columnaris'* from a bed of seedling junipers in the 1930s. At that time, Fairview Evergreen Nurseries grew many plants from collected seed, and this particular seedling quickly stood out for its vigorous, upright habit and attractive medium-green color. It also displayed two types of foliage – scale and needle type, and produced small blue berries later in the season which added to its appeal. The Hetz's Columnaris made its first appearance in our retail catalog in 1942, and it has remained a favorite in the nursery trade ever since. Over the years, our Canadian nursery friends began referring to it as the "Fairview Juniper," a name now just as familiar as Hetz's Columnaris.

Our newest introduction, *Taxus cuspidata 'Nova'*, found its roots in the mid-1970s when Leroy Hetz took side-branch cuttings from a block of *Taxus capitata*. Terms

A 5% discount is allowed on invoices paid in advance or on delivery, meaning payment is mailed same day as delivery; 2% discount within 10 days or NET 30 days from invoice date to customers with established credit. No discount is allowed until all prior invoices are paid in full. A service charge of 1% per month (12% per annum) is assessed on all overdue accounts.


